

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MONTHLY PARKING PERMIT FEE
FOR MOBILE HOMES AND REGULATING MOBILE HOME PARKS

The Town Board of the Town of Smelzer do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The provisions of s. 66.058, Wisconsin Statutes, and the definitions therein are hereby adopted by reference.

SECTION 2. There is hereby imposed on each occupied, nonexempt mobile home located in the Town of Smelzer a monthly parking fee as determined in accordance with s. 66.058, Wisconsin Statutes. Said fees shall be paid to the Town treasurer on or before the 15th day of the month following the month for which such fees are due.

SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful for any person to establish or operate upon property owned or controlled by him within the Town of Smelzer a mobile home park without having first secured a license therefor from the Town clerk. The application for such license shall be accompanied by a fee of \$2 for each space in the existing or proposed park but not less than \$25. The license shall expire one year from the date of issuance. Such parks shall comply with Wis. Adm. Code H 77, which is hereby adopted by reference.

SECTION 4. (a) Licenses of mobile home parks and owners of land on which are parked any occupied, nonexempt mobile homes shall furnish information to the Town clerk and Town assessor on such homes added to their park or land within 5 days after arrival of such home on forms furnished by the Town clerk in accordance with s. 66.058 (3) (c) and (e), Wisconsin Statutes.

(b) Occupants or owners of nonexempt mobile homes parked outside of a mobile home park shall remit such fees directly to the Town treasurer as provided in section 2. It shall be the full and complete responsibility of the licensee of a mobile home park to collect such fees from each occupied, nonexempt mobile home therein and to remit such fees to the Town treasurer as provided in Section 2.

SECTION 5. Any person, firm or corporation who fails to comply with any provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00 together with the costs of prosecution for each violation and in default of payment thereof shall be imprisoned in the county jail of Grant County, Wisconsin, until payment of such forfeiture and costs, but not exceeding 30 days, provided that the maximum forfeiture for violation of Section 4 (a) shall be \$25.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect June 1, 1970 and all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or contrary hereto are hereby repealed, except nothing in this ordinance shall be interpreted so as to conflict with State laws or orders regulating mobile homes or mobile home parks or any of the requirements of any ordinance of the Town of Smelzer not mentioned or made inapplicable by the express terms of this ordinance.
