It shall be the full and complete responsibility of the licensee of a mobile home park to collect such fees each occupied, nonexempt mobile home therein and to remit such fees to the Town treasurer as provided in Section 2. such fees to the to the Town from

SECTION 5. Any person, firm or corporation who fails to comply with any provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00 together with the costs of prosecution for each violation and in default of payment thereof shall be imprisoned in the county jail of Grant County, Wisconsin, until payment of such forfeiture and costs, but not exceeding 30 days, provided that the maximum forfeiture for violation of Section 4 (a) shall be \$25.
