

Amendment to Snow Removal Ordinance No2-2015
Town of Smelser

Level of Service:


No Town of Smelser roads will receive service between the hours of 8:00PM and 4:00AM on weekdays or on weekends unless deemed necessary by patrolman or board members. With exception to freezing rain or ice events, the Town will not operate on the road system between the hours of 8:00PM and 4:00 AM except for emergency situations. On weekends, the Town will not begin operations until there is a snowfall event of greater than 2 inches in depth or freezing rain or ice events.

Abrasives will be applied to areas of the roads where deemed necessary upon determination by the Patrolman or Board member. The Patrolman shall refrain from winging back and clearing shoulders during after-normal-hours timeframes. Winging and pushing back of snow from shoulders for future events shall occur during the normal hours of work for Patrolman.

Damage to Property in the Right-Of-Way:

The Board recognizes some properties belonging to private landowners exist within the Town of Smelser right of way; in particular mailboxes and fences. The Town shall exercise care when plowing around property of private landowners in the right of way when recognized as being an encroachment. The Town of Smelser shall be responsible for mailboxes which are hit by Town of Smelser equipment and machinery, in the amount of \$30.00 per mailbox.


